



Copying notes is an important way to reinforce topics learned in class.



Seeing course information on the board, hearing us discuss it in class, and writing it down all help to shift the information from short-term memory (the kind students forget before they get to their next class) into the long-term memory which will support them throughout the year and on the regents exam.

Different students write at different rates. We don't want any students feeling rushed or to write illegibly because of time. Therefore, we are making the key to every unit note packet available on the class website (www.protopage.com/albertina). We will pace the filling in of these packets by assigning certain pages for homework on different days (see eSchool portal for HW assignments and dates.)

Notes will be checked to make sure they are completed and that they are in the student's own handwriting. Printed notes will not be accepted as they do not reinforce information.

Having the notes available online also supports students who are absent so they will not fall behind.
